Terms and Conditions Trinity College London CertTESOL course

Trainee enrolment on Trinity CertTESOL course in Thailand is subject to agreement to the following terms and conditions:

1. In order to secure a place on the Trinity certTESOL course, candidates must pay the online fee due within one week on after acceptance is confirmed. This will be after the interview.
2. The balance of course fees should be paid no later than 6 weeks before the first day of the requested onsite course.
3. All fees paid are for consecutive weeks of study and include input sessions, teaching practice and any other tests. Moderation from Trinity College London is included in the cost. The moderator from Trinity College London may record interviews with trainees on the final moderation day. If a trainee is referred for any part of the course they may be required to pay an additional fee directly to Trinity College London to retake that particular component.
4. In case of trainee *cancellation* of attendance onsite of the Trinity Cert TESOL course, the following conditions will apply;
 - a) More than 28 days before the course start date the applicant will receive a full refund of the balance payment of the course minus the online component fee and any transactions costs incurred.
 - b) Less than 28 days before the course starts there will be no refund.
5. In case of request for *postponement* of attendance on the Trinity Cert TESOL course, the following conditions will apply:
 - a) More than 28 days before the course start date the deposit, and any money paid towards the balance will be valid for a future course subject to availability.
 - b) Less than 28 days before the course start date, the deposit and any money paid towards the course start date **may be** valid for a future course at the discretion of Trinity TESOL Thailand
6. Trinity TESOL Thailand cannot give refunds or be held responsible for the late arrival, early departure or any absence of candidates for any circumstances during a course. This includes delays or quarantine issues incurred by Covid 19 restrictions.
7. Trinity TESOL Thailand reserves the right to cancel any course up to 4 weeks before the start date due to unforeseen circumstances. In this case full fees will be refunded.

8. No Thailand visa or work permit is implied, guaranteed, or secured by enrolment in the Trinity Cert TESOL. Trainees are advised to apply for a 60 day tourist visa before arrival in Thailand.
9. Trainees agree to dress in a manner befitting a professional teacher while attending the course. This would include a collared shirt, trousers/skirt, shoes.
10. Trainees must inform Trinity Cert TESOL of any breakages or damages to equipment or accommodation while partaking of the onsite Trinity Cert TESOL. The trainee must settle the cost of the damage before he or she leaves the course. Trinity TESOL Thailand accepts no responsibility or liability for any loss or damages directly or indirectly caused by any trainee.
11. In the event of the centre having to close and/or trainees having to return home before the stated end date of the course for reasons, which are beyond the reasonable control of the school, no refunds will be given. Trinity TESOL Thailand will make every effort to continue the course providing that the safety of its trainees and staff are not in jeopardy.
12. Candidates are strongly encouraged to arrange medical insurance before arriving at the Centre. Trainees will be responsible for their own medical expenses, if any, while attending the course.
13. Trinity TESOL Thailand cannot be held responsible for loss or theft of personal belongings
14. Trinity TESOL Thailand consider the following points inappropriate behaviour for a trainee while onsite.
 - a) Behaving in a disruptive, abusive or culturally insensitive manner
 - b) Regular absence from class
 - c) Engaging in illegal activity as recognized under Thai law

Any such behavior will be deemed in breach of the school's internal code of conduct. Depending upon the severity of the breach of conduct, individual trainees may be asked to leave the course and school premises immediately.

To be accepted on the Trinity Cert TESOL course you should be at least 18 years old and able to demonstrate the following criteria:

The ability to cope with the academic demands of the course. This could be a university degree (in progress or finished) or academic qualifications, which would allow access to a degree course. In the case of candidates without the above, skills acquired through work experience may be taken into account.

The ability to communicate well in spoken and written English as demonstrated during the initial interview process.
